PLOUGHING CLASSES

BEFORE Friday 11th SEPTEMBER 2026

- Class 1 Vintage tractor ploughing by tractors manufactured prior to 1st January 1960, using similar age **mounted** plough with any number of furrows (skimmers & tailpieces optional).
- Class 2 Vintage tractor ploughing by tractors manufactured prior to 1st January 1960, using similar age **trailed** plough with any number of furrows (skimmers & tailpieces optional).
- Class 3 Classic tractor ploughing by tractors manufactured after 1st January 1960 and prior to 1st January 1976, using similar age **non-reversible mounted** plough with 2+ furrows fitted with mould boards of corresponding age to the plough.
- Class 5 Vintage/Classic tractor ploughing with mounted or trailed non-reversible plough for competitors who have not won a prize in the past two years and for Novice Ploughmen/women
(Help and guidance will be given)
- Class 6 For users of 2 – 4 Furrow Reversible Ploughs excluding Match Ploughs.
- Class 7 For users of 5+ Furrow Reversible Ploughs excluding Match Ploughs
- Class 8 For users of reversible ploughs with any number of furrows, who are resident in the County of Essex and Employees of the machinery dealers of the manufacturers they represent.
- Class 9 For users of a reversible Plough excluding Match Ploughs competitors who have not won a prize in the past two years and for Novice Ploughmen/women

Classes 1 - 5 commence at 9.30am and finish at 1.00pm. Classes 6 - 9 commence at 11.30am and finish at 1.30pm.
